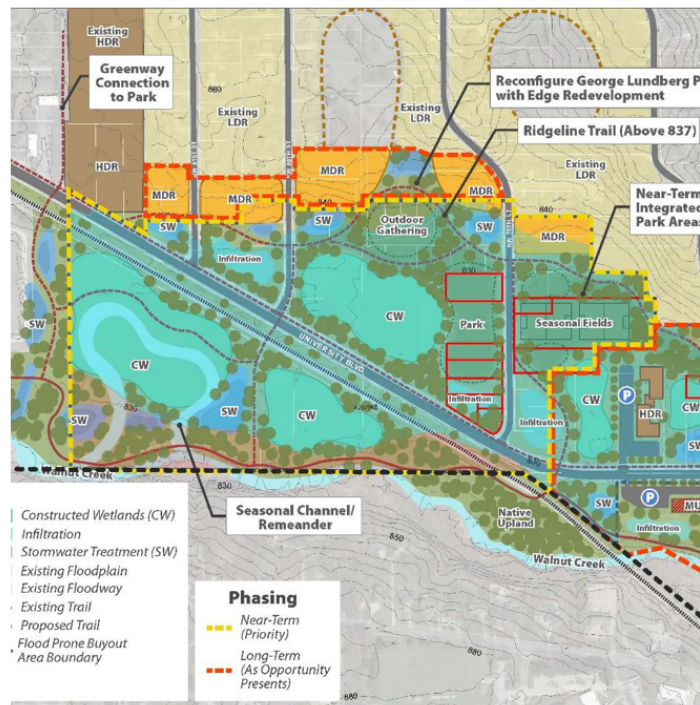

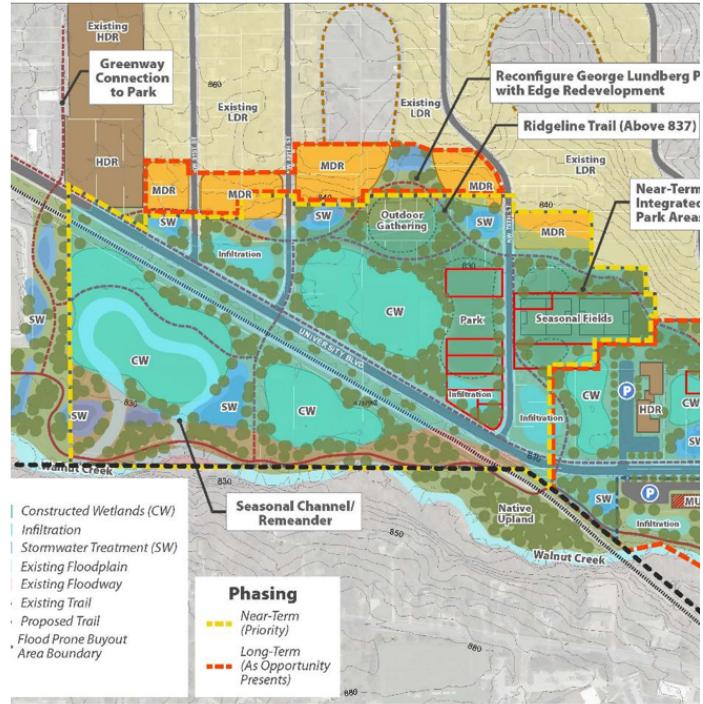
RE: University Boulevard Flood Mitigation- Project Scoping Plan Discussion

### SYNOPSIS:

**Project Kick-Off Meeting-** Discussion primarily around confirming the overall project goals/objectives for the work to be completed during the development of the University Boulevard Flood Mitigation- Project Scoping Plan. In a nutshell, the project is intended to complete various technical work necessary to find partners/funding pathways to achieve “what we want” the flood buyout space to become. Staff’s current understanding of what we want is based on the conceptual 86<sup>th</sup> Street Neighborhoods Plan which illustrates a resilient nature-based floodplain connected to the neighborhood that catalyzes community reinvestment. Over the next 9-12 months, we intended to take the concept and begin to explore technically feasible water quantity/quality and community space alternatives and ultimately narrow down to one or more specific actionable/fund-able preliminary projects. To that end, it is my desire to make sure that our collective “what we want” focus is correctly calibrated before we spend our time/energy figuring out “how” to achieve the desired outcome.

This workshop is intended to provide a space for you to throw out specific ideas/suggestions for what you want to see and how you want the space to interact with the neighborhood. Also important to understand is if there are any cautionary elements that you don’t want us to lose sight of as we get into the project.
